****Auditions will be on Saturday, August 22nd****

Douglas Darlings

- Ages 7-10
- All participants need to attempt to do their splits all three ways (right, left and middle)
- Know basic techniques including chasse', single right and left turns, channe' turns, pivots, three step turns, v-step, etc.
- Available to take 1 hour of ballet class per week in addition to 1 hour of dance team per week at a discounted rate.
- Available for 1 volunteer event per month.
- Participants must be available to perform at community events monthly.
- Participants must be enrolled in dance team and ballet for the entire school year. During the summer, dance team is not required, but because this is our busiest performing time, dance team members will not be allowed to perform unless they are enrolled for the summer.
- Participants are required to do fundraisers.
- Participants are required to wear any kind of leotard to audition in. They may also wear any cover up they choose. Jazz shoes are required.
- Audition time on August 22nd will be from 10:00 a.m. until noon. For the first hour, an audition dance will be taught as well as three dance combinations. Judging will be from 11:00 a.m. until noon. As the groups audition they will be allowed to leave.
- Results will be posted on Sunday by noon at the dance studio or participants can call the studio line to hear the

Pointe Requirements

****Auditions will be on Saturday, August 29th****

- Must at least be 11 years old
- Five years of proven ballet experience
- Doctor's Release
- Must be enrolled in 1 hour of Ballet III in addition to 1 hour of Pointe each week.
- Required dress code includes a leotard and tights and hair pulled back away from face. You may wear any cover-up you choose. Ballet shoes are required as well.
- Must be familiar with all foot and arm positions, plie's, tendus, degages, ron de jams, single and double right and left turns, channe' turns, pécay turns, leaps, chasse', reverse channe's, attitude, arabesque, pas de chat, switch jumps, releve', torjetes, balance', devlope', fondu, etc.
- It is recommended that all students interested in pointe enroll in Ballet III during the summer to make sure that they are prepared for the audition.
- Audition time on August 29th will be from 10:00 a.m. until noon. For the first hour, an audition dance will be taught. The audition will heavily focus on technique. Judging will be from 11:00 a.m. until noon. As the groups audition they will be allowed to leave.
